The cities visited on the tour will include Washington DC (3 days), Boston (3 days) and New York City (6 days including the conference).

The tour is specifically aimed at mid to upper level executives associated with the real estate and planning industries and from both the private and public sectors.

The tour is being marketed and promoted not only in Australia but also in South East and North East Asia. Accordingly it is expected that the tour group will comprise participants from several different countries.
