## 1.30PM Case study #3: Lifehub @ Daning

Lifehub @ Daning is a retail-anchored mixed-use development project in Zhabei, Shanghai. Developed by Chongbang Group and completed in 2006, Life Hub @ Daning consists of 15 buildings with approximately 250,000 sqm of GFA. It is a great example of how a well-designed and executed project can serve as a catalyst to transform an urban neighborhood. The case study provides key details of the project and the neighborhood, the developer's overall concept for the project, the development and financing of the project, and key success factors as well as what the developer would do differently with the benefit of hindsight.
