OVERVIEW AND APPLICATION PROCESS

ULI Australia Members who are active contributors to the Institute on a local, national and/or global level, are encouraged to apply for the 2018 ULI Australia Young Leader Scholarship. The purpose of this Scholarship is to support the professional development of young leaders in the real estate or land use industry.

This Scholarship includes:

- Complimentary registration to the ULI Australia Young Leaders Group Study Tour of Hong Kong as a delegate from 1 June to 4 June 2018;
- Complimentary registration to the ULI Asia Pacific Summit in Hong Kong as a delegate from 5
 June to 7 June 2018; and
- Up to \$2,000 AUD in reimbursement for accommodation and travel expenses.

The Scholarship will be awarded to a ULI member who meets the following criteria:

ULI member: must be Australian based, under 35 years of age at 30 June 2018, and a highly engaged member of the ULI Young Leaders Group for a minimum of 12 consecutive months immediately prior to the application date and maintain their membership for a minimum of 12 consecutive months following the application date.

ULI commitment: demonstrates engagement and leadership within the ULI on a local, national and/or global level, and who will show continued commitment to ULI after the Study Tour and Summit.

Work experience: has 3+ years' experience in the real estate or land use industry (including but not limited to disciplines such as development, architecture, planning, government, transportation, engineering, finance, sustainability, law and not-for-profits) and be an emerging leader in the industry.

Applicants are encouraged to review the Scholarship <u>Terms of Reference</u> for full details on Eligibility, Conditions, Costs, Judging, Application Process and Deadlines and Timing. Note upon return the Scholarship winner is required to write a 750 1,000 word article reflecting on their experiences and key takeaways.
